# LIVING RULES AND LAWS

The legal system, based on drinking regulations, noise and violence on public, smoking regulations and punishments.





### LEGAL AGE FOR DRINKING

#### "THE LEGAL AGE FOR DRINKING IS 19."

The age is calculated based on the calendar year rather than birthdate. This means that individuals born in the same year are all legally allowed to drink from **January 1 of 2024** for those who are turning 19, regardless of their specific birth date.



### DRINKING RULES AND REGULATIONS





ID, residence card or passport must be presented when buying alcohol.



Alcohol consumption in alcohol-free zones or public spaces fines up to 100,000 Won.



Using someone else's identification is prohibited.

# UNDER AGE DRINKING & PUNISHMENT



#### 'No' drinking with minors allowed

No alcohol can be ordered where minors are present, like in **karaoke venues, restaurants, bars,** and **convenience stores.** 



#### Under age drinking punishment

Up to **three** years in prison or fine up to 30 million won for the minors' parents.



# DRUNK DRIVING REGULATIONS



Age of Driving

The minimum age to drive and obtain a driver's license is **18** years old.



Drunk driving punishment

- 1-6 years of imprisonment or 5-30,000,000 KRW fine.
- Temporary or permanent license cancellation.

"Excessive noise is prohibited in apartment areas after 10 PM."

#### Violations may result in fines or penalties:

Passengers on public transport, like buses and subways, are encouraged to avoid loud talking and disruptive phone use.






"Drinks in single-use containers are prohibited in the bus."

#### Noise Violence on public transportation:

Disruptive noise on public transport includes loud conversations, playing music without headphones, shouting, and loud phone rings.





"All types of the noise violence are considered as illegal."



#### **Violence and Vandalism:**

• Acts of violence or theft against self service machines, including vending machines and ATMs, are taken seriously.

• Such actions can lead to criminal charges, fines, community service, or imprisonment depending on the extent of the damage and the circumstances of the offense.



"Any violence committed under the influence of alcohol is punishable."

#### **Drunk Violence:**

Engaging in such actions can have serious consequences, which may include imprisonment, fines, detention, or other penalties for violations of the law.



## SMOKING POLICIES AND REGULATIONS

Smoking is not allowed with the sign 'Geumyeonguyeok.'

"In Korea, the legal smoking age is 19, and purchasing tobacco products requires an ID card, residence card, or passport."

### DRUG RESTRICTION POLICY

"All types of drugs are illegal unless they are approved for medical use and have the confirm prescription."

#### 1.PSYCHOACTIVE SUBSTANCES

- Poppy, Opium
- ·All alkaloids extracted (Heroine, Morphine, etc)

### PUNISHMENTS





#### **POSSESSION**

Imprisonment of 1 ~ 10 years or fine under 100,000,000 KRW.



#### TRADE/PRODUCE

Over 5 years-lifetime imprisonment or fine up to 100,000,000 KRW.



#### **USAGE**

Imprisonment of 1 ~ 10 years or fine under 100,000,000 KRW including Korean citizens.

### SEXUAL VILOENCE



All types of sexual violence are subject to punishment

South Korea has extremely strict laws against unauthorized intimate photos, videos and AI generated content.

Sneak photo/video shooting.

Distribution of illegally taken photographs or

videos.

Sexual harassment.

Sexual assault.

Stalking.

Al made photos and videos. (Deepfakes)



### SEXUAL VIOLENCE

Under current legislation, individuals can face severe penalties for:

- Covert recording of intimate body parts.
- Upskirt photos.

• Any non-consensual filming in public or private spaces.

#### **PUNISHMENTS:**

Fine up to 30 million KRW.

2 Imprisonment up to five years.



Driving in South Korea requires adherence to specific laws and safety protocols to ensure not only your own well-being but also the safety of others on the road. The country has a well-regulated traffic system with strict rules designed to minimize accidents and maintain smooth traffic flow.



### PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

South Korea's public transportation system, including **subways**, **buses**, and **taxis**, is efficient, affordable, and easy to navigate, with the **T-money** card providing a convenient payment method for all modes of transport.

### T-MONEY





- Buy /Charge T-money in convenience store. (GS25, CU, 7-Eleven etc.)
- Need to inform the bus driver if it's paid for two people.
   (Du-myeong ieyo)
- Make sure the transaction worked. (Sound-> Gamsahapnida)

#### RULES IN PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION



Yellow seats for elderly people and people with physical disabilities. Pink seats for pregnant women.

Seats for transportation vulnerables.

If you are healthy, give up your seat to elderly people.

No food and drinks.

> Keep the volume down.

### **JAYWALKING**

Crossing a road illegally, typically outside of designated areas or without following traffic signals.

- Before crossing the crosswalk, look left and right and cross.
- Fine up to 20,000 ~ 30,000 KRW
   Detention or Penalty for Violations

**02** Exchange students cannot apply.

03 Minimum GPA of 2.0 is required.

Maximum of 40 hours of work per month.

(minimum wage of 2024 = 9,860KRW/ \$7)



### PART-TIME JOB REQUIREMENTS

"Working outside of the campus without permission is illegal."



#### **Applicant Eligibility**

Registration Card with student visa. (D-2)

GPA over 2.0 in the previous semester.

Currently enrolled at Korean University. (less than 8 semesters of enrollment)

#### PART-TIME JOB VIOLATIONS

"Working outside of the campus without permission is illegal."

#### **Example of violations**

- Private Tutoring
- Construction
- Delivery worker
- A workplace located more than 60 minutes away
- If the permission for the activity was obtained by providing the false information or by the other illegal means


#### **Penalties for violations**

- Paying a fine
- Departure due to visa extension denial
- Deportation

### OTHER TYPES OF FRAUD

#### Loan scam

Impersonation a financial company and pretending to be a lender through a text message on a mobile phone, collecting fees and disappearing.

### Cryptocurrency scam

A fraud offering huge profits by trading cryptocurrency such as Bitcoin.



### Pyramid scheme investment scam

A fraud that involves recruiting new inventors by facing them with guaranteed principal and high profess, as well as promising additional profits or dividends if they further investors.

#### **Debt loan scam**

A fraud where a person is coaxed into taking a lower interest loan in order to pay off an existing one.






#### **Before Contract**

- 1. Check if the estate agency and realtor is registered www.nsdi.go.kr
- 2. Search appropriate market price rt.molit.go.kr
- 3. Check if the landlord has the ability to pay tax

#### **During Contract**

- 1. Verify landlord's identity (ID card)
- 2. Use the house rental standard contract rtms.molit.go.kr

#### **After Contract**

- 1. Report move-in and receive the confirmed date <a href="https://www.gov.kr">www.gov.kr</a>
- 2. Reconfirm the rights relationship
